

Categories: Bass, Flounder, Speckled Trout, Redfish

1. Participation and Eligibility. Participation is open to anyone 18 years of age or older. However, minors are eligible to participate with a parent or legal guardian signature on the release form. A completed entry form, waiver, and entry fee must be received no later than the published entry date. Further agree to indemnify and hold Dog River Clearwater Revival, its officers, members, agents, and sponsors harmless from and against all claims, liabilities, and causes of action resulting directly or indirectly from participation.

2. Pre-Registration and Captain's Meeting. The registration fee for this event is set at \$35 for adults (age 16 & up) \$20 for youth (ages 15 & under). Register in person at the Southern Bama Bait & Tackle (4012 Dauphin Island Pkwy, Mobile, AL 36605) or the River Shack Restaurant (6120 S. Marina Dr., Mobile, AL 36605) until noon Friday, November 10th or online until midnight November 10, 2017. Optional Captain's Meeting is Friday, November 10, 2017 from 6-9 PM at the River Shack.

3. Safety. Safe boating must be observed always. During competition each contestant is required to comply with US Coast Guard and Alabama State Regulations including the possession of PFDs and sounding device. If you find yourself in an emergency please call 911 or channel 16 on a VHF radio.

4. Weigh In. Angler must be in line by 3PM to qualify. Weigh in station will be operational beginning at 1:00 PM on Saturday, November 11th. Any anglers in line at the weigh-in station at The River Shack Restaurant at the 3:00 PM cutoff time will be allowed to weigh in their catch. If an angler arrives after the 3:00PM deadline, the catch will not qualify. There will be no exceptions to the rule. Official time will be kept by the Tournament Committee and/or Weigh master at the weigh-in station.

All competitors must check in with legal fish (Alabama Fish and Game Regulations) to be eligible for fishing prizes. Only legal 'slot' redfish Redfish (16-26 inches with pinched tail) will be weighed in the

tournament. THIS REDFISH "SLOT" RULE GOES FOR ALL AGE CATEGORIES. All fish submitted for weigh-in must be fresh and caught that tournament day. The weigh-master will make decisions on accepting fish for weigh-in, his decision is final. Any attempt to enter fraudulent catch, tamper with catch, or to hamper or threaten any official of the tournament will result in immediate disqualification. Fish will be weighed in the order in which they are checked in. You may wish to provide ice and a cooler to keep your fish fresh. All weighed fish will be marked to indicate the fish has been processed at the weigh in station. The largest fish will be determined by weight. In the event of a tie, the first fish entered will be considered the winner, and the other will be dropped to the next position. Weigh Master's decision is final. No protests.

5. Permitted Fishing Methods. All fish must be caught via hook and line. The selection of baits is up to the discretion of the participant.

6. Fishing Locations. The fishing area will be all inshore Alabama waters (Mobile and Baldwin Counties only).
